

PUBLIC NOTICE OF ENACTMENT OF A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF LACROSSE IN ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA

The Town of LaCrosse Town Council at the regular meeting on Tuesday, October 14, 2025 at 6:00 pm will consider the proposed resolution for enactment. The meeting will be held at the town hall located at 20613 N SR 121, LaCrosse, Florida.

The Resolution title is as follows:

RESOLUTION NO 2025-03 TOWN OF LACROSSE, FLORIDA

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LACROSSE, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 196.1978(3)(o), FLORIDA STATUTES, ELECTING TO NOT EXEMPT PROPERTY UNDER SECTION 196.1978(3)(d)1.a, FLORIDA STATUTES, COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE “LIVE LOCAL ACT PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION”; PROVIDING FINDINGS OF FACT IN SUPPORT THEREOF; PROVIDING DIRECTION TO THE TOWN CLERK; REPEALING ALL PRIOR RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

At the regular meeting of the town council, all interested parties may appear and be heard with respect to the proposed Resolution. Copies of the proposed Resolution are available for public inspection at the office of the Town Clerk, 20613 N SR 121, LaCrosse, FL 32658 during regular hours Tuesday and Thursday, 9am to 2pm. Notice is given pursuant to Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes, that in order to appeal any decision made at the public hearing, you will need a record of the proceedings, and that, for such purpose, you may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
