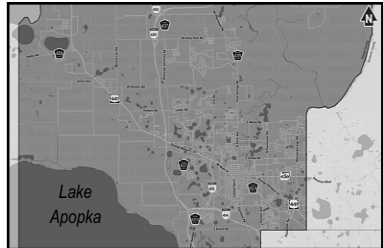


PUBLIC NOTICE

Northwest Orange County Areawide Transportation Study (NOWOCATS) *Community Meeting No. 2, June 16, 2026*

Orange County, in partnership with the City of Apopka, invites the community to attend Community Meeting No. 2 for the Northwest Orange County Areawide Transportation Study (NOWOCATS). Orange County and the City of Apopka are undertaking NOWOCATS to proactively develop a transportation system that can support anticipated growth while preserving the unique character of the region. The study will function as a long-range transportation plan, identifying and analyzing potential projects to improve connectivity, reduce congestion, and enhance mobility for all modes of travel. The purpose of this second of two community meetings, is to present the findings and recommendations of the proposed future year 2050 transportation needs plan, and to obtain your feedback.
