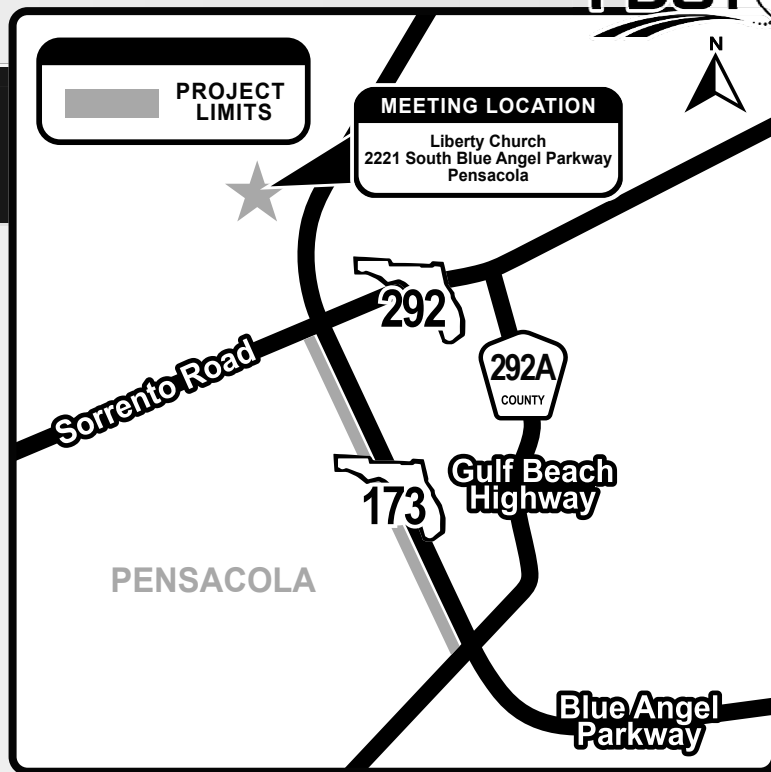

The intent of this project is to add a 10-foot-wide multi-use path along the west side of Blue Angel Parkway from Gulf Beach Highway to Sorrento Road. In addition, numerous pedestrian features will be upgraded to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act standards. No additional right of way is required. Bids for construction are scheduled to occur early 2027.
