The Miami-Dade Aviation Department (MDAD) is interested in qualified contractors willing to perform critical on-call services and emergency/priority maintenance work at MDAD's facilities in a work order-based program. The parameters of this work order-based are as follows:

The Aviation Department (MDAD) does not guarantee that the full amount of the contract will be issued to the awarded bidder. All work will be authorized as needed via Work Orders. The actual amount of the assigned Work Orders will be at the sole discretion of the MDAD. Work Order amounts will depend on the Department's needs. The total combined cost for all Work Order(s) shall not exceed the contract award amount.

Minimum Qualifications and Experience:

Below are the minimum qualifications and experience that the selected contractors must possess in order to participate in this work order based program for MDAD emergency/priority maintenance work:

1. Contractors must hold a valid license required to perform work in the following trade: TRADE MAXIMUM CONTRACT VALUE - Air Conditioning Unlimited \$200,000.

2. As per Resolution No. R-1122-21, Contractors must have a minimum of 5 years' experience performing work in their specific trade. 1. Remove and replace approximately 21,000 square feet of built-up roofing.
2. Contractor is responsible for any and all field measurements required to perform the Scope of Work (SOW) herein attached.

1. Remove and properly dispose of the existing roofing system. Prepare the roof deck to receive new insulation (if required) and roof covering.
2. Install insulation as required. Roofing system installed will be in an effort to achieve an R-6 value and a slope of no less the 1/4" pr 1" slope throughout the flat roof area.
3. Install new EverGaurd Extreme TPO 60 mil White roofing system by GAF, or approved equal (see attachment 1).
4. Energy-efficient, Cool Roof cap sheet or reflective coating will be applied to meet Miami-Dade County resolution R-54-18 "Cool Roof."
5. Acceptable alternatives include Polyglass, Johns Manville and Soprema. Follow manufacturer specification, attached, for cleaning, product attachment application and guarantee/warranty requirements.
6. Roof assembly shall meet UL Class A Fire Rating.
7. New roof drains and strainer cover to be reinstalled after the re-roofing.
8. Apply new plaster finish to two (2) low concrete walls, where light fixture and glass signage are embedded, following the architect's drawings and specifications.
9. All counter flashing and edge flashing will be stainless steel.
