Notice is hereby given that the Planning and Zoning Board of the City of Alachua will hold a public hearing on September 8, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. The hearing will be held in the James A. Lewis Commission Chambers in City Hall, located 15100 NW 142nd Terrace, Alachua, Florida, to consider the following:

Application #: PTAC26-0001 | Evaluation and Appraisal (EAR) of the City of Alachua Comprehensive Plan

A request by the City of Alachua (Applicant) to complete the required EAR update to the City of Alachua Comprehensive Plan pursuant to Chapter 163.3191, Florida Statutes. The proposed EAR updates to the City of Alachua Comprehensive Plan include amendments to the following elements: Vision; Administration; Monitoring and Evaluation; Future Land Use; Transportation; Housing; Community Facilities and Natural Groundwater Recharge; Conservation and Open Space; Recreation; Economic; Property Rights; Intergovernmental Coordination; Capital Improvements; Data and Analysis. Amendments and updates proposed are to address changes to state law and/or changed local conditions, pursuant to Chapter 163.3191, Florida Statutes.

At the public hearing, all interested parties may appear and be heard with respect to the application. Copies of the application, staff report, and any related materials are available for public inspection at the Planning and Community Development Department, 15100 NW 142nd Terrace, Alachua, Florida, on any regular business day between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. one week prior to the date of hearing. Notice is given pursuant to Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes, that, in order to appeal any decision made at the public hearing, you will need a record of the proceedings, and that, for such purpose, you may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
