NOTICE TO ALL BROWARD COUNTY RESIDENTS

Broward County Mosquito Control Aerial Spraying

Broward County Mosquito Control may perform aerial spraying throughout Broward County to reduce nuisance or disease vector mosquito populations between June 27, 2025 and June 26, 2026, which typically occurs following major rainfall events or disease outbreak. The insecticide applied during the potential aerial spray mission is Dibrom (active ingredient Naled). Dibrom is registered for use in the United States including Florida by both the US Environmental Protection Agency and the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services and has been safely used by Broward County Mosquito Control for decades. Chemically sensitive residents who have been registered with the state to be alerted prior to spraying will be notified. Residents with breathing difficulties should remain indoors during the aerial spraying. Prior to any aerial spraying missions, Broward County will issue public media announcements to inform residents in advance.
