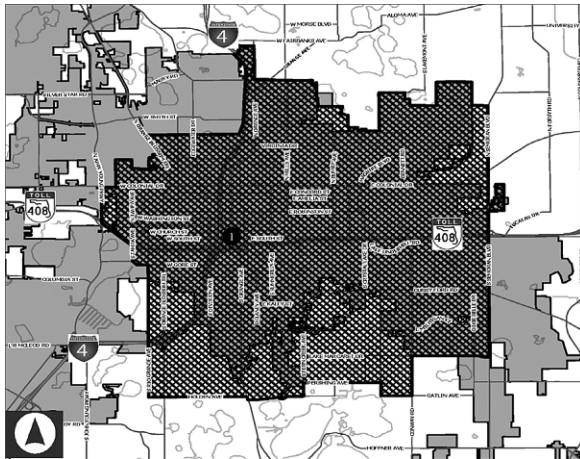


NOTICE OF LAND USE CHANGE

The City of Orlando proposes to amend the Growth Management Plan to change the use of land within the areas shown on the map below. On **Monday, June 8, 2026**, the Orlando City Council will consider proposed ordinance #2026-14, entitled: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CITY'S ADOPTED GROWTH MANAGEMENT PLAN TO UPDATE FIGURE C-8, ENTITLED URBANIZED DISTURBED LANDS TO CORRECT A MAPPING ERROR, PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE. The following amendment to the official GMP Future Land Use Map is proposed:

A public hearing on this ordinance will be held during Council's regular meeting beginning at 2:00 p.m., in Council Chamber, 2nd floor, Orlando City Hall, 400 S. Orange Ave., Orlando, Florida. Interested parties may appear at the meeting and be heard with respect to the proposed ordinance. All pertinent information about meeting access and participation instructions will be available on orlando.gov/councilmeeting at least 3 days prior to the meeting. Additionally, interested parties are invited to watch the meeting live and may participate by providing public comment during the meeting or submitting written public comment in advance regarding the proposed ordinance. The opportunity to provide public comment is available until the designated public comment portion of the item is closed. All items received are public record. The proposed ordinance may be inspected at the Office of the City Clerk located on the 2nd floor, Orlando City Hall, 400 S. Orange Ave., Orlando, Florida or online at orlando.gov. Anyone who desires to appeal an official decision made at this meeting, if an appeal is permitted by law, may need to obtain a verbatim record of the proceedings that includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is based.
