



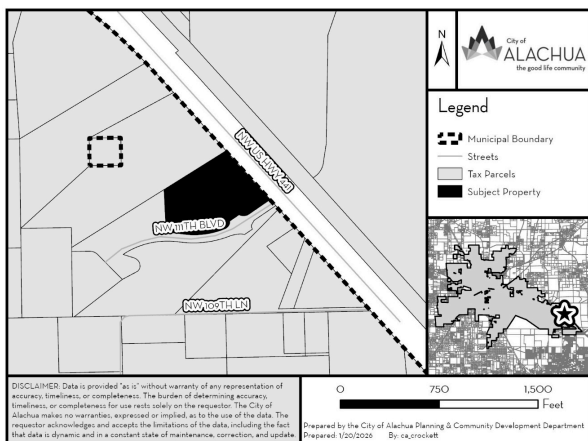

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE PLANNING AND ZONING BOARD OF THE CITY OF ALACHUA, FLORIDA

Notice is hereby given that the Planning and Zoning Board of the City of Alachua will hold a public hearing on February 10, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. The hearing will be held in the James A. Lewis Commission Chambers in City Hall, located 15100 NW 142nd Terrace, Alachua, Florida, to consider the following:

### **Application #: PSP24-0012 – Gatorland Kubota Site Plan Application**

A request by NV5, Inc. (Agent) on behalf of Gatorland Kubota Equipment Company, Inc. (Property Owner) for a site plan to construct a  $\pm$  12,550 square foot truck or tractor rental or sales with an accessory repair and servicing facility and associated site improvements on a  $\pm$  6.31-acre subject property generally located west of the intersection of US Highway 441 and NW 111th Boulevard (Tax Parcel 05885-010-011). Future Land Use: Commercial; Zoning: Commercial Intensive (CI).
