Northwest Orange County Areawide Transportation Study (NOWOCATS)

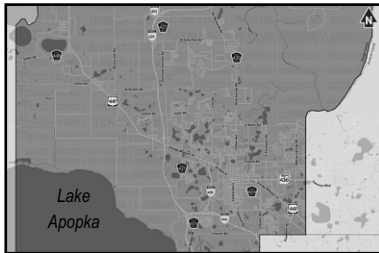
Community Meeting Series No. 1, January 26 and January 28, 2026

Orange County, in partnership with the City of Apopka, invites the community to attend Community Meeting No. 1 for the Northwest Orange County Areawide Transportation Study (NOWOCATS). Orange County and the City of Apopka are undertaking NOWOCATS to proactively develop a transportation system that can support anticipated growth while preserving the unique character of the region. The study will function as a long-range transportation plan, identifying and analyzing potential projects to improve connectivity, reduce congestion, and enhance mobility for all modes of travel. The purpose of this first of two meetings is to present the data collection findings for existing traffic conditions and 2050 model traffic forecasts, and to obtain community feedback.

Due to the size of the study area, there will be two in-person community meetings. The same information will be presented at both meetings on the following dates and locations:
