



Sunbridge Parkway Extension Project Development & Environment (PD&E) Study from U.S. 192 to Nova Road

Osceola County is conducting a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study for the extension of Sunbridge Parkway in northeast Osceola County, Florida. You are invited to a virtual Public Hearing on Tuesday, February 3, 2026, and an in-person Public Hearing on Wednesday February 4, 2026.

The Public Hearing is being held to present information and solicit community feedback on the project, which will serve as a major north-south divided corridor that would ultimately connect Irlo Bronson Memorial Highway (U.S. 192) in Osceola County and State Road (S.R.) 528 in Orange County. The extension is anticipated to be a four-lane divided roadway accommodating motorists, pedestrians and bicyclists between U.S. 192 and Nova Road (County Road (C.R.) 532) in Osceola County. Additionally, proposed improvements include enhanced access management, roundabouts for safer traffic flow, wildlife crossings, and stormwater management facilities.

Osceola County is offering multiple ways for the community to participate in the hearing. Participants may attend in person by going to the St. Cloud Community Center, 3101 17th Street, St. Cloud, FL 34769. This in-person hearing location will open the doors at 5:30 p.m. to allow participants to view the hearing materials prior to the presentation. The presentation will begin promptly at 6:00 p.m. followed by a formal public comment period.
