

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CASSELBERRY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CITY OF CASSELBERRY UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS TO ELIMINATE AND DISBAND DEVELOPMENT REVIEW COMMITTEE; AMENDING REVIEW PROCEDURES FOR DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENTS, SITE PLANS, SUBDIVISIONS, PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENTS, AND OTHER LAND DEVELOPMENT PERMIT APPLICATIONS REQUIRING DEVELOPMENT REVIEW COMMITTEE APPROVAL CONSULTATION; REMOVING REFERENCES TO DEVELOPMENT REVIEW COMMITTEE THROUGHOUT UNIFIED LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS; AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICIAL AND CITY STAFF, WHERE APPROPRIATE, TO CONDUCT REVIEWS OF LAND DEVELOPMENT CODIFICATION, APPLICATIONS; PROVIDING CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.



This notice is pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, and the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Casselberry, Florida, as amended and supplemented.

The City Commission will consider the proposed Ordinance on November 17, 2025, at 5:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible, in the Casselberry City Hall Commission Chambers, 95 Triplet Lake Drive, Casselberry, Florida. At the meeting, interested parties may appear and be heard with respect to the proposed Ordinance. This hearing may be continued from time to time until final action is taken by the Commission. Copies of the proposed Ordinance are available at City Hall with the City Clerk, and the same may be inspected by the public.
