NOTICE IS GIVEN by the City of Casselberry, Florida, that the City Commission will hold a public hearing to consider adoption of the following ordinance:

ORDINANCE 25-1626

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CASSELBERRY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 68 – ROADWAY AND UTILITY CONSTRUCTION, ARTICLE IV. – COMMUNICATIONS RIGHTS-OF-WAY, TO AMEND GENERAL PERMIT REQUIREMENTS AND SECURITY REQUIREMENTS FOR COMMUNICATIONS RIGHTS-OF-WAY UTILIZATION PERMIT APPLICANTS INSTALLING AND MAINTAINING COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES FACILITIES IN THE PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

This notice is pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, and the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Casselberry, Florida, as amended and supplemented.

The City Commission will consider adoption of Ordinance 25-1626 on **Monday, November 17, 2025 at 5:30 p.m.** or as soon thereafter as possible, in the Casselberry City Hall Commission Chambers, 95 Triplet Lake Drive, Casselberry, Florida. At the meeting, interested parties may appear and be heard with respect to the proposed Ordinance. This hearing may be continued from time to time until final action is taken by the City Commission. Copies of the proposed Ordinance are available at City Hall with the City Clerk and the same may be inspected by the public.
